

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) REOPENING JUNE 1, 2020

The Governor of Illinois has released the Restore Illinois phased plan to allow certain businesses the ability to safely reopen after May 29, 2020.

Following Phase 3 of the Restore Illinois plan, **Grand Paradise Ranch will reopen (with restrictions) for public lessons, training and boarding beginning June 1, 2020.**

We ask that ALL Grand Paradise Ranch clients adhere to the reopening guidelines outlined below. With your support and adherence to these guidelines, we will be able to remain compliant with the statewide mandate, stay open and keep safe.

LESSON STUDENTS

To ensure that we do not exceed a 10 person occupancy, a maximum of 2 lesson students will be permitted at one time.

No additional family or friends are allowed to join you during your visit. *Exception: minors may be accompanied by one adult.*

ALL lesson students will be required to provide their own helmet, riding gloves and earbuds.

Shared equipment such as bridles, saddles, halters, lead ropes, girths, whips/crops and saddle pads are to be wiped down/disinfected by the rider after each use.

BOARDERS/LESSEES

To ensure that occupancy of 10 people is maintained, we are requiring that you sign up for ALL visits online at https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10c0448a4af2caafc1-limited.

Once a day limited visits are available for 2 boarders/lessees per 2 hour time slot between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. One 3 hour time slot is available for 3 boarders/lessees from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.

No additional family or friends are allowed to join you during your visit. Exception: minors may be accompanied by one adult.

REOPENING GUIDELINES

STAY HOME IF YOU OR A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD IS SICK.

Limited occupancy of 10 people or fewer permitted.

Wear face coverings in the presence of others and maintain social distance of at least 6-feet.

Wash/disinfect your hands before entering the facility and frequently throughout your visit. Hand sanitizer is provided at barn entrance.

Disinfect gate latches, spray nozzles, cross ties, pitchforks, bucket handles, stall door latches, door knobs, light switches and other frequently used items after contact. Disinfectant will be provided.

Shared equipment such as bridles, saddles, halters, lead ropes, girths, whips/crops and saddle pads are to be wiped down/disinfected by the rider after each use.

Restrooms will be open during your visit. Viewing room will be closed.

Due to the ever-changing COVID-19 situation, these guidelines are subject to change at any time.
